Protecting What We Value

What is Suspicious Activity?

- Vehicles driving slowly in your community that you are unfamiliar with.
- Unfamiliar people in the area going door to door trying to sell merchandise or asking for assistance.
- Vehicles at your neighbor's house that you don't recognize when your neighbors are usually at work or away.
- Abnormal activity that may pose a danger to your neighborhood or community.
- Unusual sounds such as glass breaking or screaming.

What is Community Watch?

Community Watch is about neighbors taking care of neighbors and working with the Laclede County Sheriff's Office in reducing crime in the County. Here is how to get started:

- Call the Sheriff's Office and talk with Sheriff Millsap about setting up a meeting with your neighbors and the Community Policing Supervisor Cpl. Matt Frederick.
- Contact your neighbors and get them involved with the program and invite them to the meeting to discuss the program and crime in your area.
- Work with your neighbors to report suspicious activity to the Sheriff's Office

- What happened
- When did it happen
- Who was involved
- Were there weapons involved
- Is anyone hurt
- Description of vehicles & people (include clothing descriptions)
- Which direction did they leave
